Our Anti-Bullying Charter

The children of our school all believe in working towards an anti-bullying environment. We all deserve to be safe and happy.

Our definition of bullying behaviour is:

Bullying can be words or physical actions that are deliberate and repeated over time to make someone else feel uncomfortable about themselves.

Our advice is: **If you are bullied ...**

- Be firm and clear, strong and reasonable
- Get away from the situation
- Let someone know

Afterwards ...

- Tell a teacher
- Tell your family
- If you are scared, ask a friend for help
- Keep speaking up until someone listens
- Don't blame yourself

Be clear about ...

- What has happened
- How often it has happened
- Where it happened
- Was anyone else watching?
- What you have done about it already?

How do we stop bullying?

We will not let bullying behaviour carry on.

We will tell the bully to stop.

We will not let people be left out of a group deliberately.

We will tell a member of staff what is happening.

We will ask the bullied child to join our group.

We will ask the bully to join our game too.
