Willow Year 6's for having self-belief and confidence. I'm very proud of all of you – Mrs Palin.

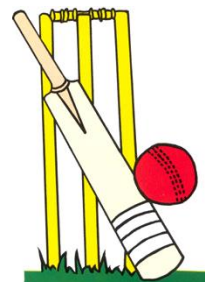


KWIK CRICKET
